

BC GUIDE OUTFITTERS GEAR LIST

Packs and bags

- ☐ Internal frame pack with good waist belt
- ☐ (Goat & Grizzly hunters app. 3500 cu in)
- ☐ (Antlered hunters app. 2200 to 3000 cu in)
- ☐ Rain cover for pack
- ☐ Sleeping bag good to -10 f (small/lite weight)
- ☐ Back packers pillow (optional)
- ☐ Nalgene water bottle or equivalent (20-32oz)
- ☐ Back pack gun carrier or equivalent (optional)
- ☐ Day pack with water bladder (Cabelas, Eberlestock packs)

Hunting gear

- ☐ 300 Magnums, 270, 30.06 or equivalent with sling (lite weight stock?)
- ☐ Trigger lock for transport (required)
- ☐ Flash light and/or head lamp (small/LEDbatteries)
- ☐ Wind proof lighter/matches
- ☐ Electric tape for rifle muzzle/duct tape
- ☐ 40-60 rounds ammunition
- ☐ Binoculars with strap (10x42 power, high quality)

- ☐ Laser range finder (suggested only)
- ☐ Mountaineering type boot (ie. Kenetrek or equivalent)
- ☐ Locking gun case (required)
- ☐ Extra shoelaces/parachute cord
- ☐ Walking sticks (collapsible trekking poles)
- ☐ Wiggis for goat or Grizzly
- ☐ Hip waders for Moose hunts

Clothing (think layers, for temperature/moisture control)

- ☐ 4-7 pr underwear
- ☐ 4-7 pr wool/boot socks
- ☐ 2 pr sock liners
- ☐ Insulated hunting jacket/hooded for cold days and later hunts, waterproof!
- ☐ 2-3 light tee shirts(Polar Max type)
- ☐ 2 pr polar long johns pants, lite weight (Smart wool)
- ☐ 1 mountain pants (outer layer) Sitka, Cabelas etc
- ☐ 1-2 pair jeans/hunting pants
- ☐ 2 pr polar long johns shirts, lite weight (Smart wool)
- ☐ Quality rain jacket/hood and pants (or equivalent, quiet)
- ☐ 1 warm cap (wool stocking cap)
- ☐ 1 ball cap or brimmed hat with neck tie

Meds and hygiene

- ☐ 70 Advil tablets (meds)
- ☐ Chap stick
- ☐ Sun screen
- ☐ Bug repellent (seasonal)
- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Camp soap/shampoo
- ☐ Camp towel and wash cloth
- ☐ 30-60 wet wipes
- ☐ Mole skin pads (blister kit)
- ☐ Small first aid kit/talc pwd.
- ☐ Personal Medication

Other gear

- ☐ Camera(small/digital)
- ☐ Extra film/batt./mem. card
- ☐ 2 small duffle bags
- ☐ Emergency blanke
- ☐ Multi-tool knife (Leatherman)
- ☐ Reading (magazines/books)

Some of this gear will not be necessary on a base camp type hunt etc.
